Bus Drivers	Includes driving buses, tour tram, and sedans for the sedan service if needed. The position is not guaranteed any set number of hours and works based on demand for the vehicles operated. The student must possess a CDL class "B" license with a passenger endorsement and no air brake restriction. This position reports to the Assistant Transportation Manager at Travel Service. Central Control Panel	Includes assisting full time staff in daily 24 hr. operation of facilities. Includes, but not limited to, maintenance of building automation and firm alarm monitoring for campus.	Applicable only to student employees in Physical Plant Services.	.20 per hour
Certified Fitness Personnel	Includes conducting safe and effective fitness workouts to groups and/or individuals of different fitness levels. Provides fun and motivational instruction and education on the benefits of healthy living through exercise. Plan, prepare and and instruct personal training sessions. Must possess current certification (i.e. ACE, AFAA,ACSM,NASM,NSCA, Zumba,Cycling, Yoga,Pilates, etc...)	Applicable only to student employees in Recreational Sports & Services.	7.00 per hour
Certified IT Technician	Includes requirement of technical certification in order for them to provide warrantied work. Will provide assistance to SIUC students in the walk-in center and for desktop support of DELL laptops.	Applicable only to student employees in Information Technology.	.40 per hour
Community Service Tutor	Includes America Reads, America Counts and Family Literacy: Students employed as Tutors for work in the America Reads Challenge program engage in tutoring elementary students in various aspects of reading /literacy. This may include, but is not limited to, being engaged in listening to children read orally and then querying the children about their understanding of background knowledge, vocabulary, story/text sense, characterization, or other facets of comprehension. Tutors may also help elementary students practice decoding, fluency, or language skills. Tutors may facilitate small group discussions of literature or content text; Tutors may scaffold elementary students' learning of science, social studies, math, or literature.	Available only to student employees in Curriculum & Instruction and must have a pre-employment background authorization clearance before an offer of employment is made.	.35 per hour
Craft Shop Instructor	Woodshop Attendant: Expertise in drill, cut and sand orders. Working knowledge of woodshop equipment, carpentry, or wood construction. Instructor: Expertise in specialized teaching areas of art.	Applicable only to student employees in the Student Center.	.20 per hour
Department Assistant Manager	Includes students who have responsibilities as assistant managers for parts of an office.		.20 per hour

Flight Instructors	Includes providing individual flight and ground instruction to students enrolled in Aviation Flight courses, and including pre- flight/post-flight inspections as well as maintaining training records of assigned students.	Applicable only to student employees in Flight Services.	.40 per hour
Law Related	Includes work for either a professor or a department within the School of Law. Work with a professor may consist of research for papers, articles or books, or assisting with class work. The Law Library, Legal Clinic and Self Help Legal Center employ law students to assist with working with clients in various ways depending upon the specialty provided by the particular client.	Applicable only to law students who are student employees in the School of Law or the School of Law Legal Clinic.	.35 per hour
